

D1/FEB14 MNL / MILAN (D)

Depart Manila on board a prestigious airline for your to Milan. Enjoy in-flight meals entertainment onboard. (Same day arrival) Flight details:

Welcome to the fashion capital of the world Milan, Italy! immigration clearance at convey your luggage and board your private coach for your transfer to hotel for check-in and dinner.

D2/FEB15 MILAN - COMO - ENGELBERG (BD)

Full breakfast and enjoy the half day guided city tour of Milan, visit and entrance to Duomo including earphone guide, view Santa Maria Del Grazie, La Scala and all other major attraction. Photo stop Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II. In the afternoon free time for leisure. Transfer to Como a city at the southern tip of Lake Como in northern Italy. It's known for the **Gothic Como Cathedral**. Continue to Engelberg a town in Central Switzerland for hotel check -in.

D3/FEB16 ENGELBERG - GIESSBACH - ISELTWALD -INTERLAKEN (BD)

This morning experience the mind-blowing day in the Snow at one of the lovely mountain resort of **Mount Titlis** in Switzerland with 10,623ft high above sea level. Take the world's first rotating cable car and be amazed to the spectacular view up to the summit of Mt. Titlis and enjoy the Illuminated Glacier Cave, experience the Titlis Cliff Walk – the highest elevation suspension bridge in Europe. Ri Jeong-Hyeok poignantly reminisces his time playing the piano in solitude on his wooden stage built on the picturesque Lake Brienz. Later on proceed to the adventure capital of Switzerland, Interlaken for hotel check in.

INTERLAKEN - SIGRISWIL - BERN -D4/FEB17 TITISEE - FREIBURG (BD)

Today we travel to Strasbourg from Freiburg the richest city in Alsace with its historical and architectural heritage. See the UNESCO listed *Grand Ile, Strasbourg*

Cathedral and Palais Rohan, stroll around La Petite D10/FEB23 PARIS (BD) France and along the canals. In the afternoon proceed to Luxembourg for a city tour with your English speaking guide. Luxembourg is famous for its medieval fortified Old town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site at the shores of the River Alzette.
