Tour Highlights: Jerusalem, Bethlehem, Masada, Dead Sea, Nazareth, Tiberias, Caesarea, Haifa, Rosh Hanikra, Acre, Cappadocia, Konya, Pamukkale, Kusadasi, Ephesus, & Istanbul

Day 01 / SUNDAY

ARRIVAL BEN GURION – JERUSALEM

Meet and assist upon arrival at Ben Gurion airport. Transfer to your hotel in Jerusalem for check-in and overnight.

Day 02 / MONDAY

JERUSALEM – BETHLEHEM (B)

After breakfast, drive to Mount of Olives and enjoy a panoramic view of Jerusalem City. Proceed to Mount Zion, visit King David's Tomb, the Last Supper Room and the Dormition Abbey. Enter the Old City and walk through the Armenian and Jewish quarters to the recently excavated and restored Cardo. See the Jewish Wailing Wall, the Kotel. Proceed to the Christian Quarter. Walk through the Via Dolorosa and visit the church of the Holy Sepulchre. Drive to Bethlehem; visit the Nativity Church and the Manger's Square. Enjoy a view of the Shepherd's Field. Back to your hotel for overnight.

Day 03 / TUESDAY

MASADA – DEAD SEA (B)

After breakfast in the hotel, cross the Judean Desert to Masada. Visit the Last Fortification of the Jews against the Romans. Ascend by Cable Car. Visit the remains of the walls, palace, synagogue, water cisterns, mosaic floors, Roman baths and other findings. Descend by Cable Car. Visit the Dead Sea, the lowest Spot on Earth. Enjoy a bath if weather permits. Return to your hotel for overnight.

Day 04 / WEDNESDAY

NAZARETH – TIBERIAS (B)

After breakfast, drive North to Nazareth City. Visit the Church of Annunciation and the Church of St. Joseph. Proceed via Cana, to Tiberias City on the Sea of Galilee. Drive along the lake, visit Capernaum and view the ruins of the Ancient Synagogue. Proceed with the visit of Tabgha, site of miracle of the multiplication of fishes and loaves. Proceed to the Jordan River to visit the Yardenit site where Jesus was baptized. Back to your hotel for overnight.

Day 05 / THURSDAY

CAESAREA – HAIFA – ROSH HANIKRA – ACRE (B)

After breakfast in your hotel, drive to Caesarea, visit the Roman Theatre and the Crusader's Fortress. Proceed to Haifa City, enjoy the panoramic view of the City, the Port and the Bahai Gardens. Drive to Rosh Hanikra, visit its Limestone Grottos. Proceed to Acre City considered as World Heritage Site by the UNESCO. Enter the Old City; walk through the Market, the Mosque and the Old Port. Visit the Crusaders and Underground City. Return to your hotel for overnight.

Day 06 / FRIDAY

TEL AVIV / ISTANBUL (B)

Depart from Tel Aviv airport for your flight to Istanbul (airfare not included). Then transfer to your hotel for overnight.

Day 07 / SATURDAY

ISTANBUL – ANKARA (B D)

After breakfast, check-out of your hotel then board coach for your transfer to Ankara. Dinner and overnight stay in hotel in Ankara.

From Istanbul to Ankara: Approximately 4hours & 30minutes drive

Day 08 / SUNDAY

ANKARA - CAPPADOCIA (B L D)

After breakfast, proceed to your city sightseeing including the famous Museum of Anatolian Civilizations and the Mausoleum of Ataturk, founder of modern Turkey. Then continue to Cappadocia via the Salt Lake. Lunch enroute. Arrival to hotel. Dinner and overnight.

Day 09 / MONDAY

CAPPADOCIA (B L D)

After breakfast full-day is dedicated by exploring the amazing world of Cappadocia, unique in the world for its moon-like landscapes. Visit the amazing underground city of Kaymakli used by the Christians of the 7th century as a refuge from the Roman persecutions, rock-carved churches in Goreme, troglodyte villages and fairy chimneys at Urgup, Avclar and Uchisar. Lunch at a typical restaurant. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 10 / TUESDAY

CAPPADOCIA – KONYA – PAMUKKALE (B L D)

Breakfast at hotel and departure for Konya, the former capital of the Seljuk Empire. Visit enroute the Seljuk Caravanserai of Sultanhanı. Arrive at Konya and visit the Mausoleum of Mevlana, the great philosopher who founded the sect of the Whirling Dervishes. Continue to Pamukkale. Lunch enroute. Arrive at Pamukkale and enjoy the sunset on its unique formation of petrified calcium cliffs. Transfer to your hotel for check-in, dinner and overnight.

Day 11 / WEDNESDAY

PAMUKKALE – KUSADASI (B L D)

Morning breakfast at hotel. Visit the ancient city of Hierapolis and the hot-spring pools of Pamukkale, a spectacular natural site of dazzling white castles. Lunch enroute. Drive to Aphrodisias and visit the ancient city dedicated to the Goddess of Love, Aphrodite. Continue to Kusadasi for check-in to your hotel. Dinner and overnight.

Day 12 / THURSDAY

KUSADASI – EPHEBUS – IZMIR / ISTANBUL (B L)

Morning breakfast at hotel. Departure to Ephesus, one of the best preserved cities of ancient times. Visit the Ruins, the Odeon, the Temple of Adrian, the famous Roman Baths, The Library of Celsius, the famous Theatre, etc. in continuation, visit the House of Virgin Mary and St. John's Basilica, the sacred places for pilgrimage. Then transfer to Izmir airport for your flight to Istanbul (airfare not included). Arrival then transfer to your hotel for check-in.

Day 13 / FRIDAY

ISTANBUL / DEPARTURE (B L)

The tour starts with a breath-taking tour of the Roman Hippodrome; once, center of horse races, chariot rallies and Byzantine civic life. Today only remain three monuments: The Obelisk of Theodosius, which was originally 30m tall., the bronze Serpentine Column, which was built to commemorate the Greeks who fought and defeated the Persian Empire at the Battle of Plataea (479 BC). And the column of Constantine, also known as the Burnt Stone, is a Roman monumental column constructed on the orders of the Roman emperor Constantine the Great in 330 AD. Blue Mosque; with its harmonious cascade of cupolas and six minarets, is certainly one of the most majestic and elegant mosques of Istanbul. Saint Sophia; built in IV century. The Basilica of St. Sophia is unquestionably one of the finest examples of Byzantine architecture, with its immense dome and beautifully preserved Byzantine mosaics. Topkapi Palace; residence of the Sultans during the Ottoman Empire, today is one of the richest museums in the world, with priceless jewels, thrones, tiles, collections of porcelains and sacred relics. Grand Bazaar; covered bazaar, known worldwide, is a real shopping paradise with its more than 4,000 shops. After the tour, transfer to Istanbul airport for your continuing flight (airfare not included).
